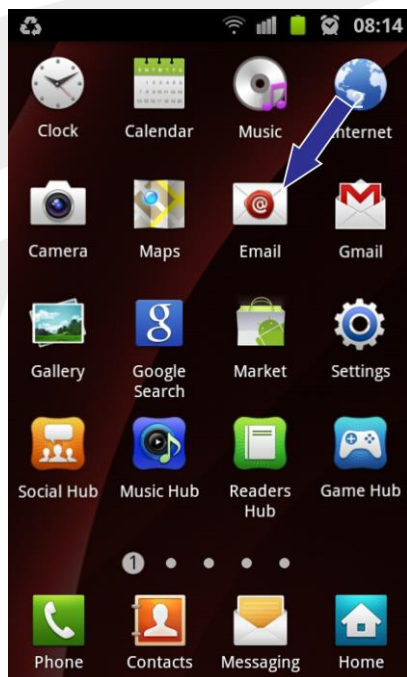


Setting up IMAP on an Android phone

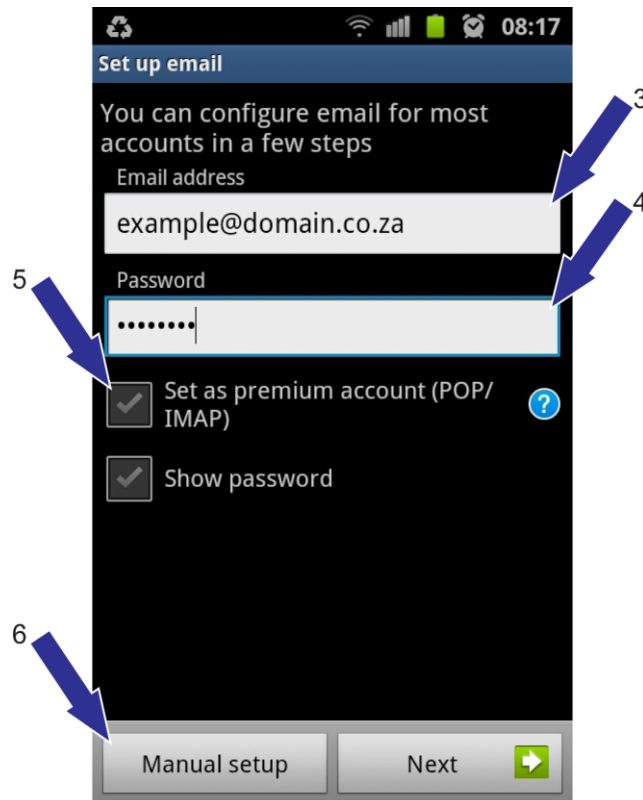
1. Tap on Applications



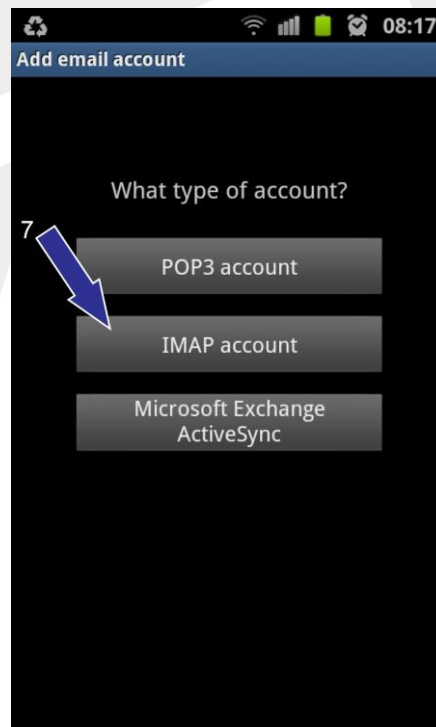
2. Tap on Email



3. Enter your email address and password (tick "Set as premium account" if this is your main email account), and then tap on Manual setup



4. Click on POP3 or IMAP (IMAP should be used in most cases, if you only check your emails on your phone you can select POP3 but it is still not recommended)



5. Enter your username, password, POP3 server and port number, then tap Next

6. Enter your username, password, POP3 server and port number, then tap Next

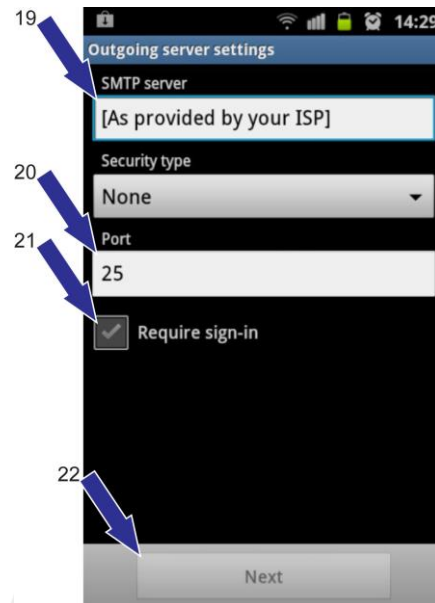

7. Enter your SMTP server as provided by your ISP; security type will normally be None. The port number is 25 but it might change depending on your ISP. "Require sign-in" should also normally not be ticked, unless specified otherwise by your ISP. Then tap Next



8. Select how often your phone should check for new emails, and whether you should be notified of new emails, then tap Next



9. Fill in the account name and Your name fields, then tap on Done
