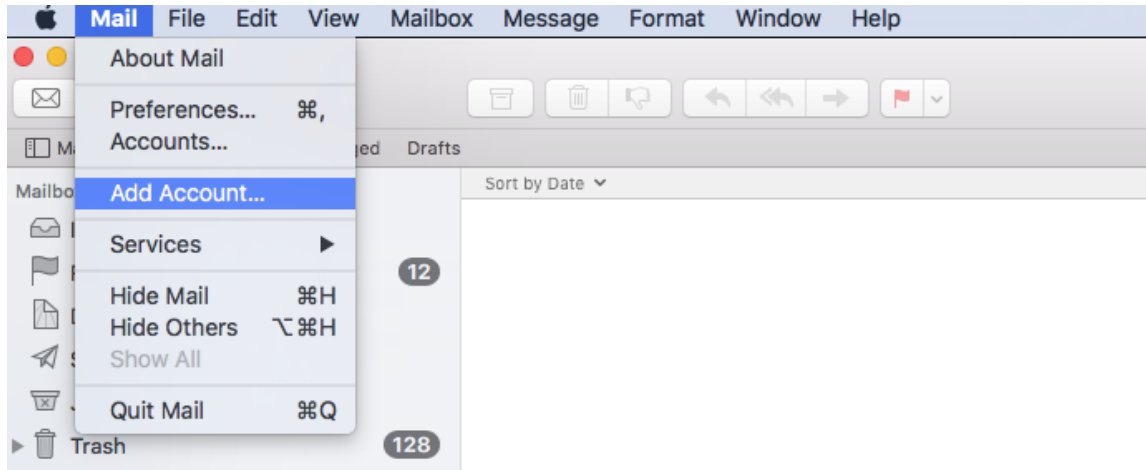
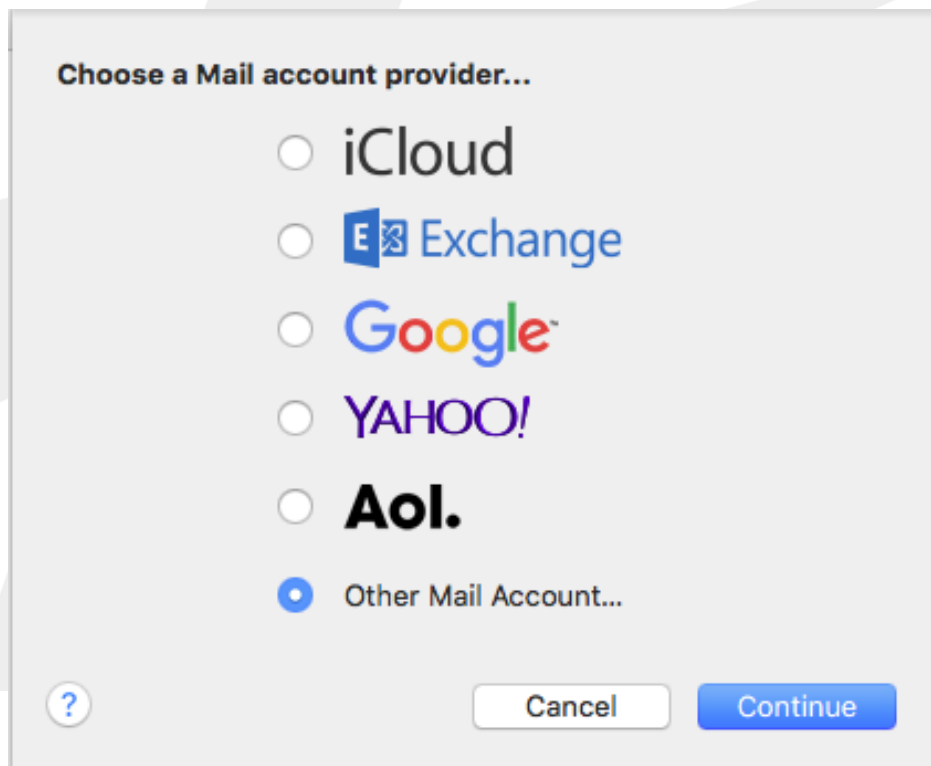


Setting up an Apple Mail account for IMAP


1. Click on "Mail" and then "Add Account" to add a new email account



2. Select "Other Mail Account" from the selection and click "Continue"



3. Enter your Name, Email Address and Password as supplied and click on "Sign In"


